
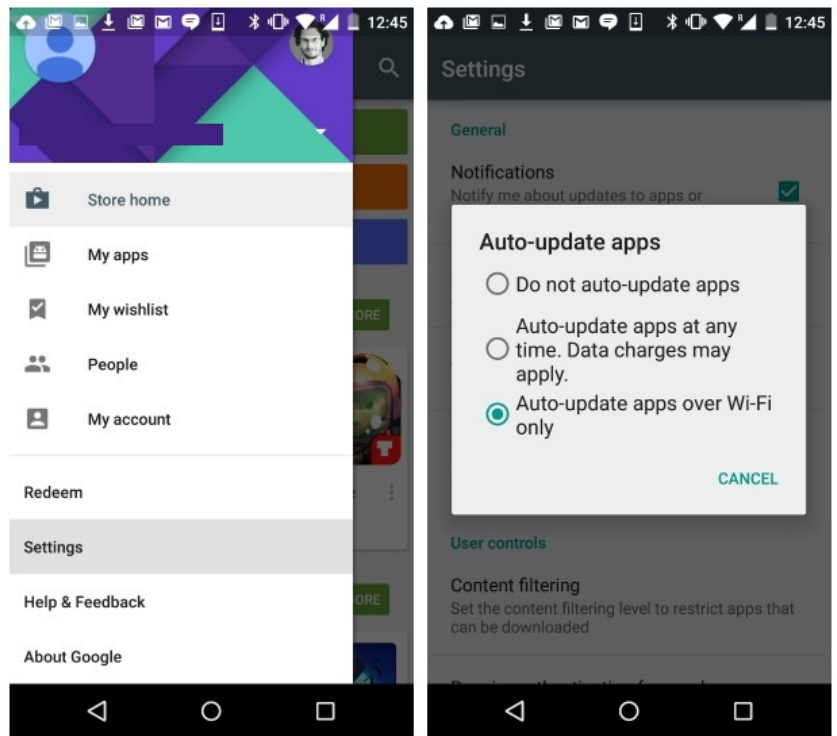


How to Update Android Apps Automatically



To automatically update all apps on your Android device

1. Open the Google Play Store app
2. Tap Menu  icon and then Settings
3. Tap Auto-update apps
4. Select Auto-update apps over Wi-Fi only
5. Over any network to update apps using either Wi-Fi or mobile data. (If you choose the anytime option there may be data charges)
6. Over Wi-Fi only to update apps only when connected to Wi-Fi.

Note: If an account on your device has a sign-in error, apps may not update automatically.



To set up auto updates for individual apps on your Android device

1. Open the Google Play Store app
2. Tap Menu  icon and then My apps & games
3. Select the app you want to update
4. Tap More 
5. Tap Enable auto update.
6. The app will update automatically when updates are available.

To turn off automatic updates, uncheck the box.
