YES! The individuals listed above are allowed to be the PAS DSW.

NOTE: Spouses are only allowed to be the DSW if they are determined to meet the extraordinary care criteria.



NO! RRs are not allowed to be the PAS DSW.



YES! Children, children-in-law, and/or other relatives are allowed to be the PAS DSW.



YES! Friends or other non-relatives that do not live with the participant are allowed to be the PAS DSW.

YES! Friends or other non-relatives that live with the participant in a home owned by the participant are allowed to be the PAS DSW.

CAN A
PARTICIPANT LIVE
WITH THEIR DSW
(FRIEND OR OTHER
NON-RELATIVE) IN
A HOME OWNED
BY THE DSW?



NO! Participants are not allowed to live in a home owned by the PAS DSW (friend or other non-relative) or owned by the PAS provider agency or an employee of the provider agency.
